Background:

The City of Watertown provides septic haulers with an opportunity to dump waste at our Waste Water Treatment Facility for processing. The City charges \$32.00 per 1,000 gallons dumped – with a limit of 18,000 per hauler per day. The City of Watertown is one of the only municipalities that makes available these services in the surrounding area.

To ensure orderly use of this service, the City licenses haulers each year. As part of this arrangement, the hauler lists the City as an additional insured, agrees to pay dumping charges, and represents that it is disposing of approved waste.

Staff recommends the City Council approve licenses with Albin's Septic, Volkenant, Inc., Chip's Septic Service, Elmer J. Peterson Co., Jim's Excavating, LLC, Duane's Septic Service, LLC, Sewer Services, Inc., Gluntz Construction/Septic, LLC, Kothrade Sewer Water & Excavation, and Mid MN Septic Services.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING LICENSES
FOR LIQUID WASTE HAULERS**

WHEREAS, the City of Watertown (the “City”) permits the dumping of domestic liquid septic waste at its waste water treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined to provide for orderly management of this service it shall license and charge a fee for this service; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the approved licensed liquid waste haulers to dump permitted waste at City facilities to be:

1. Albin’s Septic
2. Volkenant, Inc.
3. Chip’s Septic Service
4. Elmer J Perterson Co.
5. Jim’s Excavating, LLC.
6. Duanes Septic Service, LLC
7. Sewer Services, Inc. (pending submission of application materials)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Watertown, Minnesota, hereby approves licenses to be issued valid until the end of April 2019 to approved liquid waste haulers.
