Stephanie Mastel, 308 Territorial Street East is requesting that approximately 225' of the 300 block of Territorial Street East be signed as a no parking area. The street area in question is not directly on Territorial Street East but rather a frontage road to three properties in the 300 block (*see map*).

Ms. Mastel reports that the street is narrow, and if a car is parked there it prohibits larger vehicles such as garbage trucks, snow plows, emergency vehicles, etc. from reaching her residence. The street width is 213'. The City typical minimum standard is 28' and shall be posted no parking.

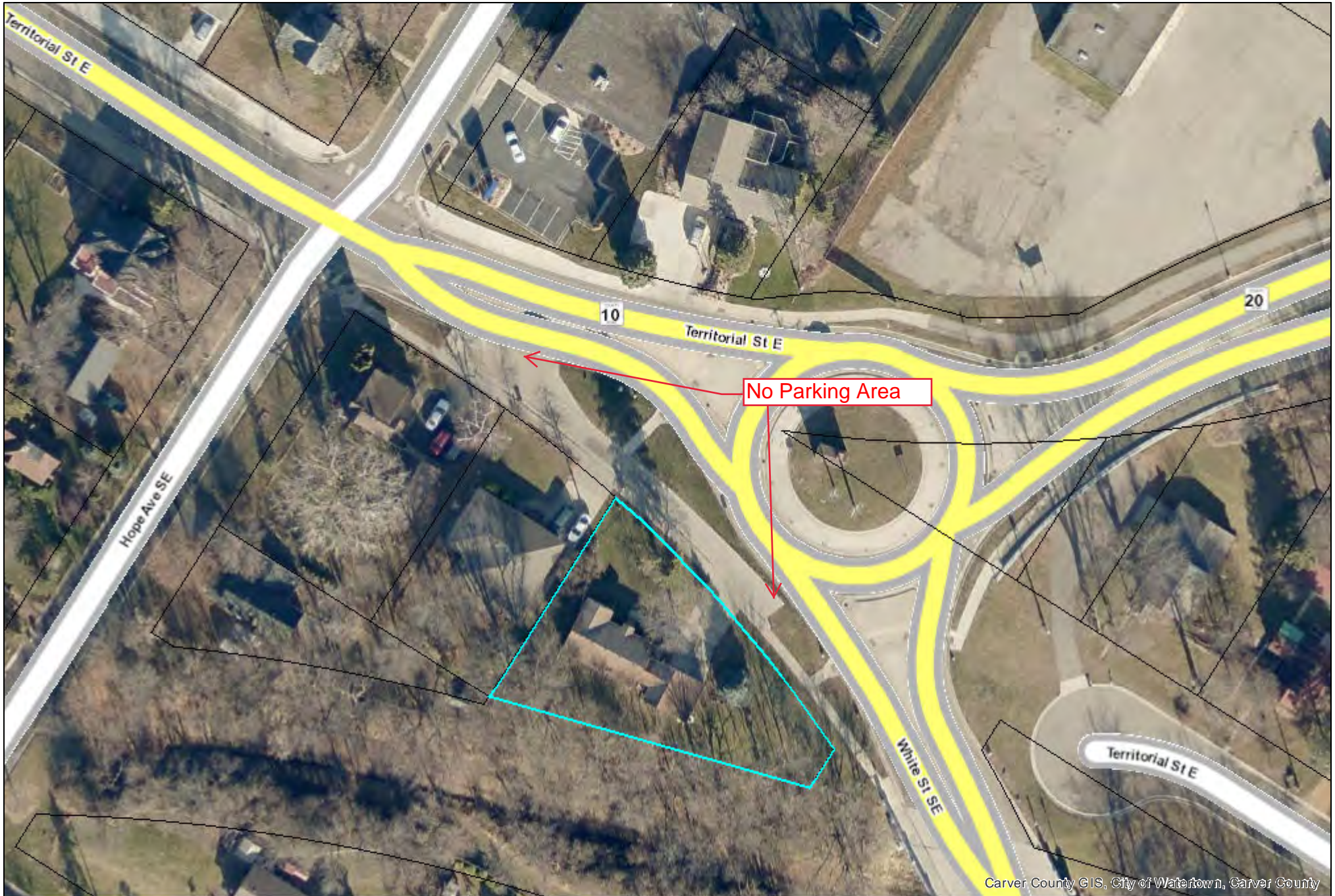
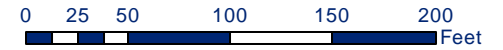
