**Background:** The Watertown Lions Club has applied for an intoxicating liquor temporary license under the provisions of Watertown Code – Chapter 6 to serve "strong" beer and wine at the Watertown Rails to Trails Festival from July 19 through July 21st, 2019. The Watertown Lions have provided liquor liability insurance through Jan. 1, 2020 as well as the applicable payment of \$200 per the 2019 fee schedule.

**Recommendation:** City Staff recommends that the Council approve the application for the temporary intoxicating liquor license from Watertown Lions Club for The Rails to Trails Festival.
